

IN-PERSON WORSHIP SERVICE

Based on recent changes in the conditions of the pandemic and the Session-approved Policy and Protocol to manage in-person worship services at New St. James, in-person worship services will resume. In-person worship service will recommence on Sunday, March 13, 2022. Pre-registration will no longer be required. However, as before, you must be fully vaccinated and follow the necessary health requirements: wearing a disposable 3-layer/surgical mask (if you do not have one it will be provided) maintaining distancing, and hand sanitizing. Spoken responses will be permitted during worship; however, singing by the Congregation will not yet resume. In order to limit the time spent indoors, it is requested that you arrive between 10:10 and 10:20 a.m. You will be checked in upon arrival and shown to designated seating in the pews and are requested to depart promptly upon completion of the worship service.
